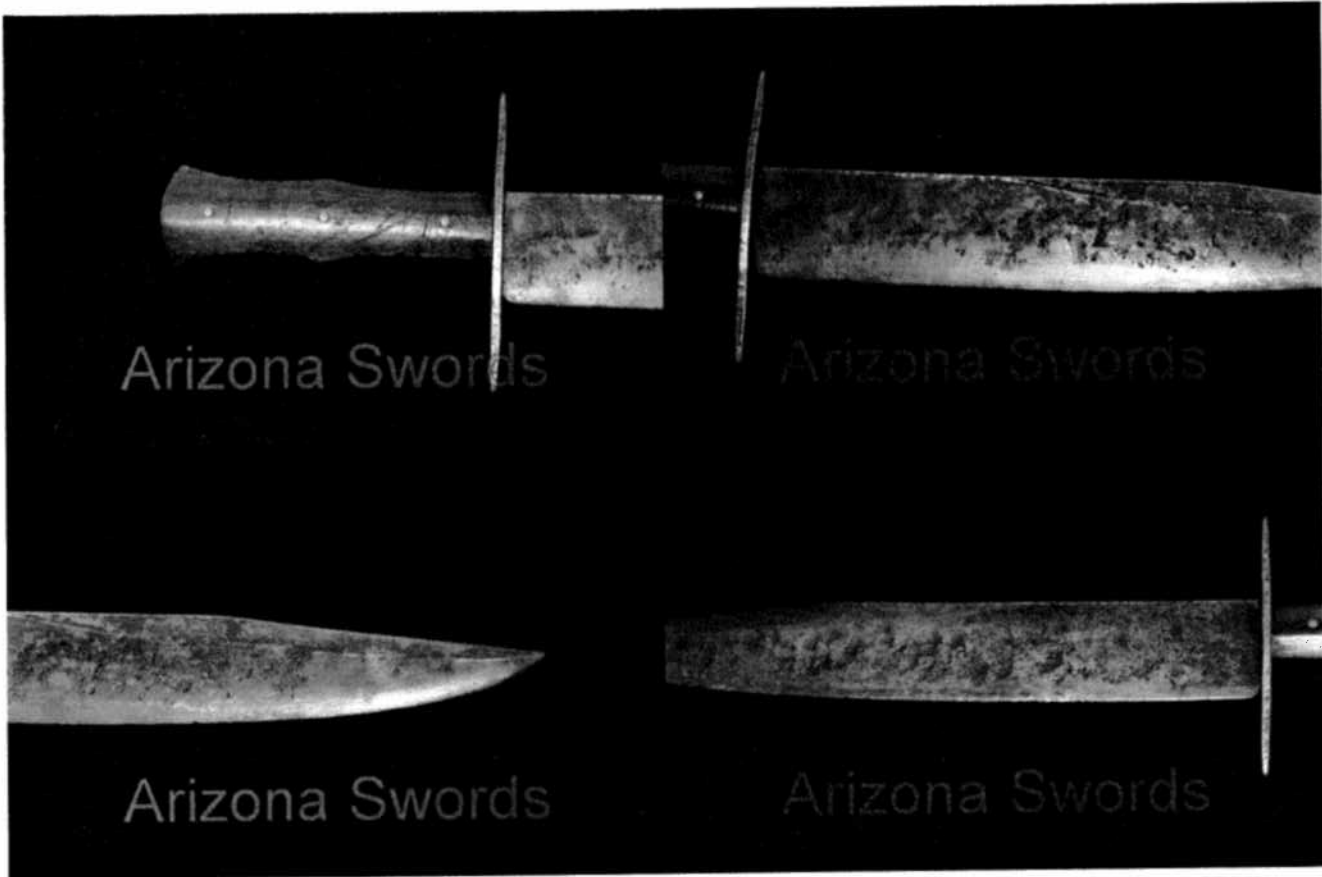



**CONFEDERATE BOWIE KNIFE:** This is a Confederate Bowie knife made from a file and you can see the teeth on the both sides of the blade. The blacksmith put a lot of pride into this knife. It is 16 1/4" long with an 11 1/4" by 1 5/8" blade. The grip is made of dark walnut and is tight with three copper pins. The blade and wood have great untouched patina. This knife was also authenticated by Lee Hadaway, and most likely was made by the same blacksmith.

Concerning the knife pictured below, I believe it is Confederate Bowie/Side Knife made by a blacksmith in the early part of the Civil War.

The skill of the blacksmith is reflected in the quality of this knife. The size and weight combine to form a knife that is balanced, user friendly and feels good in the hand. The coffin style grip is unique to Confederate knives, but other grips of this style have been noticed on similar knives, usually attributed to the same unknown North Carolina maker.

Overall Length - 16 3/8"

Blade Length - 11 1/2"

Blade Width - 1 5/8"
