

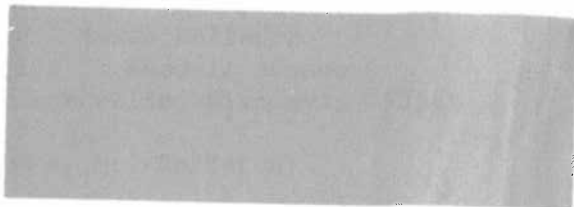

Remarks: The revolver is custom embellished in 24K gold as follows: scroll engraving on the cylinder and muzzle end of the barrel, the model name "The Legend" inscribed on the right side of the barrel, a pair of cowboy boots on the right side of the frame, a bucking bronco with rider on the top of the backstrap, three horseshoes on the revolver butt, and the inscription "Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association" down the backstrap.

Each revolver is also furnished with a Galco holster and rig featuring a brass Colt serpentine logo medallion.

"The Legend" is the first Colt firearm to be officially sanctioned by the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association. As the first edition Colt Rodeo revolver, this arm represents another milestone in the lineage of Colt historical and collectible firearms.
